## Entry guidelines:

1. All participants may enter up to 5 quilts. Cascade will make its best attempt to display all quilts entered. However, space is limited. Please assign a Display Priority number to your entries (1, 2, 3, 4, or 5) on the entry form line with the title. Cascade will hang the quilts based on your numeric assignment.
2. The Fee Schedule is outlined above. **To qualify for the Mail-in registration discount, the entries must be postmarked by Saturday, September 4, 2011.** All other entries will be charged the Drop-off entry fees.
3. All fees must accompany the registration forms. **Please make checks payable to Cascade Quilt Guild.**
4. Please sew a label on the back of each quilt with your name (required) & address (preferred). This label will be covered during judging.
5. Each entry must be clean, odor-free, and in excellent condition. Please remove stray threads or pet hair. Cascade Quilt Guild has the right to refuse any quilt that does not comply.
6. No quilts over 120" on the longest side will be accepted. Quilts may be folded to accommodate display area. The integrity of your quilt will remain intact.
7. Copy additional entry forms as needed.
8. Unless specified on the registration form, all entries will be judged and ribbons awarded at the judges' discretion. A written evaluation will be returned to the entrant for each judged quilt.
9. Cascade Quilt Guild reserves the right to categorize each quilt to the proper classification for judging within the specific context and needs of this show.
10. Ribbons may be awarded in each category at the discretion of the judges. Overall show ribbons for Best of Show, Judge's Choice and Viewers' Choice ribbon may also be awarded.

## Drop off & Pickup Instructions:

- Drop off: Fellowship Hall Bath Church, 3980 West Bath Road, Bath Ohio 44333; Saturday, Sept. 10 and Sunday, Sept. 11, 2011 between 1 p.m. and 4 p.m.
- Please deliver each quilt in its own labeled pillowcase; the pillowcase label must include your name and the name of your quilt.
- All quilts must be picked up Sunday, September 18, 2011, at the church following the close of the show and its take-down.
